



Campus Life Private Schools Field Staff

Description:

Since 1944, Youth for Christ has had a distinctive history of sharing the hope of the gospel with young people. With over 35,000 paid staff members and ministry leaders that serve in over 100 countries around the world, YFC reaches young people everywhere, working together with the local church and other like-minded partners to raise up lifelong followers of Jesus who lead by their godliness in lifestyle, devotion to prayer and the Word of God, passion for sharing the love of Christ and commitment to social involvement.

Campus Life is a program of Youth for Christ that has been active throughout the United States for over 65 years. Campus Life has over 1,000 sites located throughout 40 states. Along with trips and events, our weekly meetings address issues students face while relating them to basic Christian principles.

Greater Cleveland Youth for Christ (GCYFC) is pleased to announce an opening with our team of youth ministry leaders. We are looking to add a Campus Life Field Staff dedicated to serving students on co-ed and all-girls private school campuses.

Responsibilities:

The Campus Life Private Schools Field Staff will participate in all aspects of the local area ministry, including program execution and management of the relationships between students, parents, ministry leaders, school faculty/administration, donors, and the local community we serve.

Working under the leadership of the Private Schools Director, the Private Schools Field Staff will:

- Model authentic faith in Jesus Christ.
- Participate in regional ministry including:

Relational Ministry: Developing authentic Christ-sharing relationships with middle and high school students through a variety of methods including "contacting" (supporting current students and meeting new students at games, plays, and school events), shared experiences, appointments, small group meetings, events, and trips.

Meetings: Supporting student leaders in leading weekly faith-based club meetings on the co-ed and all-girls campuses the program serves.

Events: Facilitating monthly off-campus events to gather students across all private schools for a social activity.

Trips: Recruiting students to attend retreats and summer programs. Additionally, facilitating retreats and leading at summer programs.

Administrative tasks: Managing student information, expense reports, weekly activity reporting, etc.

Networking: Building relational network of parents, faculty/staff, alumni, area church leadership, etc. to serve on Community Support Team and/or participate as ambassadors of the ministry.

Development: Participating in efforts to expand the knowledge and reach of the ministry including informational living room presentations, meetings with current or prospective financial partners, fundraisers, and partner appreciation events.

Curriculum: Collaborating with student leaders to develop curriculum plan each year for club meetings. Some resources provided plus an opportunity to write own.

Training: Attending trainings including YFC Regional Leadership Conference, overnight trainings with partner organization twice annually, monthly staff trainings, and on-the-job training.

Credentialing: Becoming certified with the National movement, YFC/USA

Additional responsibilities:

- YFC Staff participation - Participate in all meetings: supervisory, development, trainings, retreats and events as requested as part of the staff team.

As an employee of Youth for Christ and a minister of the gospel, YFC expects all employees to:

- Seek God's guidance and wisdom, through prayer and meditation, for the organization as a whole as well as for specific ministry initiatives.
- Participate and lead regular times of prayer, devotion, and worship as a regular aspect of the role within YFC.
- Teach and preach from the holy Bible at meetings, conferences, camps, and events.

Requirements:

- A strong commitment to the Christian Gospel; will be required to sign and abide by the YFC Statement of Faith
- Undergraduate degree
- Previous employment or volunteer experience with a church or ministry such as YFC strongly preferred
- Familiarity with private and independent schools and private school culture is strongly preferred
- Availability to work full-time; some early mornings, nights, and weekends required. Able to serve on summer programs for 2-3 non-consecutive weeks.

Compensation:

- Salary: Competitive salary, commensurate with experience
- Benefits: full medical, basic dental, life insurance, and voluntary vision, 403(b) retirement plan.
